\$30,000 awarded to downtown artists

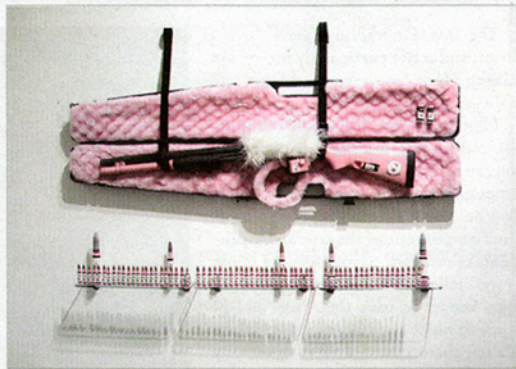

Bumdog won a \$5000.00 grant from the Downtown Artists' Project (DAP) and the Los Angeles Downtown Arts District Space (LADAD) to finish a digital movie he first conceived of two years ago when he woke up in

a parking lot on 2nd and Hewitt. A respected regular in the downtown arts scene, Bumdog is the author of "Sketches of Nothing by a Complete Nobody."

Other \$5000 grant winners are painter, sculptor and instal-

lation artists Richard Godfrey, sculptor Heather Carson, and performance and installation artist Martin Durazo. Lesser grants were also awarded to photographers Allan Barnes and Jaime Scholnick, sculptor YaYa

Chou and painter Jennifer Cunningham.

The judging panel consisted of five Los Angeles-based art professionals: gallery owner Bert Green of the Bert Green Gallery downtown; David Lawrence of the David Lawrence Gallery in Beverly Hills; Alena Gatti, Assistant Director of the Sixspace Gallery in Culver City; Angelene

Campuzano, Senior Public Art Officer of the MTA and Adolfo Nodal, Commissioner of the Los Angeles Department of Cultural Affairs. The project organizer was DAP Chairman and LADAD Treasurer Mark Walsh.
