## downtown artist project grant winners show

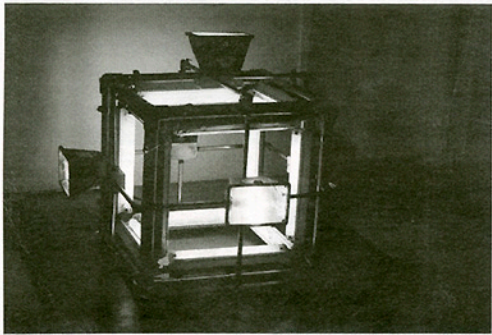
The Downtown Artist Project (DAP) awarded \$30,000 in grants to local artists in the spring to complete works now on display at Dangerous Curve Gallery. Eight out of 50 proposals submitted by artists listed on the Downtown Artist Guide were awarded grants of up to \$5000 each. The show runs through September 8 at 1020 East Fourth Place in the Arts District.

The winners are Allan Barnes, \$2250 (photo portraits of mariachis); Bumdog, \$5000 (digital movie); Heather Carson, \$5000 (light sculpture installation, six giant cubes); Yaya Chou, \$2250 (sculpture installation. Color Based child-shaped glass bottles full of artificially colored liquid); Jennifer Cunningham, \$500 (a series of watercolors of historic downtown theaters for postcard publication); Martin Durazo, \$5000 (In My Next Life, a video, performance and installation combination, using an Air Stream trailer); Richard Godfrey, \$5000 (large kinetic sculpture); Jaime Scholnick, \$4800 (16 piece installation of photographs about caged pit bulls and incarcerated men).
